### **Successful Networking 101**

I have been emphasizing that you do not need to attend Chamber programs and events to receive value from your membership. However, I know that many of you rely on networking to form relationships that help build your business. And the Chamber offers opportunities every month that are great for making connections. Some are specifically for networking and others are just as beneficial if you have a networking mindset and a strategy. Following are some thoughts on how to make networking in person work for you.

Getting started: It's natural to feel a bit uncomfortable approaching people you don't know. So, start with people you do know. They will make introductions for you. When you are introduced to someone ask about them, first if possible. Most people like to talk about themselves and will reciprocate by asking about you and your business. Turn to Chamber staff, as well. It's our job to help you make connections.

Goals: To make the most of networking, it's important to know what you're trying to get out of it. You might be building community connections, looking for opportunities to collaborate, or likely to develop more customers or clients. Be focused on your goal, but don't disengage from a conversation the moment that you think it won't benefit you immediately. That might be seen as rude. And even if you don't know how they might be a benefit to you, if you treat them well, they become a part of your network.

Follow up: You will stand out if you follow up with people you meet. It's especially important if you promised to do so. Done thoughtfully, following up makes the relationship real.

Give these ideas on networking a try. Our Biz Buzz Luncheon this month is a good place to start because it's designed so that you'll tell a lot of people about your business. But, Multi Chamber After Hours, Chamber Connections groups, committees, boards, and events all are also excellent opportunities to network. You just need a plan and get a bit out of your comfort zone.

# Applications Accepted for Vacant Port of Skagit Commissioner Position

This week, the Port of Skagit announced the sudden passing of Port Commissioner Steve Omdal, who served our community as a Port Commissioner in District 2 since 2012. Commissioner Omdal's passing creates a vacancy on the Port of Skagit Commission and, based on the legal process outlined for vacancies as written in state law (RCW 53.12.140 and 42.12.070), the Port of Skagit is now accepting applications for candidates to be appointed to that vacant position.

The appointed replacement will serve until a replacement is elected in the November 2025 general election. That elected replacement will then serve the remainder of the current sixyear term through the end of 2029. To meet the statutory deadline, the Port of Skagit must appoint a replacement within 90 days.
